REQUIRED PREAMBLE DEFINITIONS

1. `\documentclass{hayektex}`
2. `\title{...}`

OPTIONAL PREAMBLE DEFINITIONS

1. `\author{...}`. Useful for: `authhead`, `copyright`, and `title` options
2. `\email{...}`. Useful for: `copyright` option
3. `\subtitle{...}`. Useful for: `title` option
4. `\note{...}`. Useful for: `title` option

CLASS OPTIONS

Usage: `\documentclass[option1, option2, etc.]{hayektex}`

1. `title` makes a title page
2. `toc` makes a table of contents after title page
3. `center` will make all pages centered (default: asymmetric, alternating)
4. `authhead` will put author in right-odd header (default: current part)
5. `copyright` will put a copyright notice "© yourName theYear ☒" at the end of the table of contents, if it exists

PRE-DEFINED COMMANDS

1. `\margintext{...}` will place text in the side margins at the height at which it is placed in the body
2. `\runin{...}` small-caps text
3. `\say{...}` small-caps text, in the margin
4. `\begin{theorem}... \end{theorem}` bubble theorem environment
 - (a) `\theoremcolor{any dvipsnames color}` to redefine theorem color
5. `\begin{proof}... \end{proof}` bubble proof (gray) environment. Places QED at end, and proof demarker in margins
